Good Friday: The Story of the Cross: The Story of Love

Stay with the story a bit longer by choosing one of the following Creative Responses, or maybe you have your own ideas!

- Make and decorate a cross (use one of the templates if you like).
- Make a cross from twigs and string. This can be fiddly so you may need an adult to help!
- Paint or draw a cross of heart on a stone to carry in your pocket.
- Make a Holy Week wheel to tell six stories from Holy Week, with an arrow to move around the stories (use the template if you like). At St Peter's, Walworth, we depict the following six stories: Jesus Enters Jerusalem (Palm Sunday), Jesus Cleans the Temple, Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet, the Last Supper, the Crucifixion and Easter Day. You may like to choose differently!
- Make or decorate a heart to remind you of that love is stronger than death (use the heart template if you like). You may even want to write 'Love is stronger' on your heart.
- Make your own Easter Garden. There are lots of ideas of how to do this on the internet. You could make a real mini garden with plants, or use lego, or materials you have around your home.
