

Look How Much Jesus Loves Me

Stay with the song a bit longer by choosing one of the following Creative Responses, or maybe you have your own ideas!

- Use different coloured crayons, pencils, pens, or paint to show different feelings: cross, sad, scared, happy, calm, excited, or other emotions that interest the children. What does your being cross look like? What does your calm look like? What colour reminds you of “sad”? How will you hold the crayon? How hard will you press?
- Cut out pictures of faces from newspapers and magazines and create a collage of faces showing one chosen feeling, or a range of different feelings. These may be feelings from the song, or feelings that you are having at the moment, or feelings that people you know are feeling. Use glue if you have it, if not create a temporary picture!
- Explore different feelings using a mirror or a partner a piece of paper. Practise different expressions and draw a face to show that expression. Maybe you'd like to explore different colours to show different feelings as well as expressions. Our feelings change. How many different feelings can you show. Use the face template if you like.
